## ***UEFA EURO 2008™ Qualifying Draw seedings***

**Draw to take place in Montreux, Switzerland on 27 January 2006**

UEFA today announced the seedings that will be used for the draw of the qualifying competition of the European Football Championship 2006/08 to be held in Montreux, Switzerland, on 27 January 2006 at 12:00 CET.

Austria and Switzerland, as host associations, qualify directly for the final tournament. The remaining 50 associations will be drawn into one group of eight and six groups of seven teams.

The seven group winners and the seven runners-up will qualify for the final tournament.

The teams have been split into seven pots, based on the results achieved in the qualifying competitions of the UEFA European Football Championship 2004 and of the FIFA World Cup 2006. The total number of points obtained has been divided by the total number of matches to give the coefficient rankings. In case of national associations with equal coefficients, the most recent qualifying competition has been taken into account to determine the ranking. If associations were still equal, the average goal difference was determinant.

Greece, as reigning European Champions have been placed as top seed.
